IN A CONVERSATION**

to communicate simply, provided the speaker speaks slowly, clearly and rephrases sentences if necessary.



**EXPRESS
YOURSELF ORALLY**

using simple words to describe different situations, such as where you live and who you know.

The main objectives for level A1.1

- Introduce yourself / find out about the identity of someone / introduce someone
- Greet / take leave / thank / apologize
- Ask for and give personal information
- Talk about tastes
- Describe and characterize people

The main objectives for level A1.2

- Find out about places / describe and characterize places
- Make an appointment
- Ask for and give the time, timetables, give a date
- Ask for / give instructions, directions
- Ask for and give information about daily routines, a timetable
- Recount one's day
- Express quantities and measures
- Make purchases, simple transactions / obtain a service or a good
- Ask for and give prices

The main objectives for level A1.3

- Order in a restaurant.
- Make simple purchases, obtain a service or good, ask/quote prices, express quantities and measures.
- Describe/characterize people and things, find out about things.
- Talk in simple terms about one's plans.
